Important Information About Rite Aid Pharmacies in Your Area

Dear Participant and Family:

Our records show you recently filled a prescription at a Rite Aid pharmacy that is scheduled to close in the next 30 to 60 days. Before your next prescription fill, please identify another pharmacy in your area and transfer your prescription from Rite Aid to the new pharmacy using one of the methods listed below.

How to Find Another Pharmacy

Rest assured, there are many pharmacies in your network, and finding another pharmacy is simple.

- Look for a pharmacy online by logging in at express-scripts.com. Then select "Find a Pharmacy" from the menu under "Prescriptions"; or
- Call a retail pharmacy to ask if they accept your prescription plan.

Please remember, Walgreens pharmacies are out-of-network. No benefits are payable for out-of-network pharmacies, and you will pay 100% of your prescription drug cost.

How to Transfer Your Prescriptions

Once you have found a new pharmacy, take one of these easy steps to transfer your prescriptions:

- Ask the new pharmacy to call your old pharmacy to transfer your prescription(s).
- Take your prescription bottle to your new pharmacy. They'll contact your old pharmacy to transfer your prescription.
- Call your doctor and ask for a new prescription(s). You can provide this to your new pharmacy.
